### **Officer's Reports**

**Seneschal** - Trinetta - Looking at 6 officers stepping down at anniversary. Some have deputies, some do not. The call will be going out to fill in these positions, even if only on a temporary basis. Children, Rapier need deputies.

**A&S** - Flavia - I expect everyone to enter something in the A&S championship for Anniversary. A&S needs a fundraiser, so Rosamund and I will be selling grab bags, you can donate items to us to give away as well. The A&S meeting on Thursday, Aug 26 is bag-making day for the grab bags, please bring a sewing machine and scrap fabric as well as any miscellaneous items to donate.

Last month Therese led an inkle weaving class, and this month Fu Ching held a presentation box painting class and it was lots of fun. Planning more classes in the future. I will be unable to attend anniversary, but arrangements have been made for children's activities to be run by Mouren. I have donated to the Angel's chatelaine's officer a large rubbermaid container to become the new chatelaine's box.

**Boffers** - Finnguala - Stepping down, looking for a deputy. If you want to do it, get hold of Lady Bridget, or Trinnette. You need to go through training to become a boffer marshal. I will be doing boffers at Anniversary. I can't be at meetings, but I can be at events and run boffer tournaments. If someone else has the gear, we will be able to have boffer fighting at Angels events.

**Webwright** - Ysabeau - 2 days after the council meeting agreeing to get a baronial server, the kingdom webwright announced that he secured funding for a kingdom server transfer, but nothing has been heard since.. The Angels site is currently being mirrored onto the new server. The elist will also be transferred, with the least effort to our users.

### **Subgroup Reports**

**Canyons** - Gulliver - Rodak steps up as seneschal at Anniversary. Undertaking fixing up the eric and several other projects. Other officers will also be switching, and that will all be cleared up soon.

**Voyagers** - Tomaso - Still in existence, but spread around the world for the summer. We haven't been doing much at all lately. Next month the students return and things should pick up. Dabney hall is reserved for Yule, and the remodeling will be done by then.

### **New Business**

Planning Angels Events 2005:

Angels Melee - Gullvier/Canyons - Jan 15, which is against Winter Weekend as

usual or the 22 - It would be better for the barony to be able to host their Majesties, which may not be possible if they attend Winter Weekend on the 15<sup>th</sup>. Otherwise, we may be against Unbelted, which would be far worse than not having a RP. Decided to put in for 22<sup>nd</sup> for Angels Melee, 15<sup>th</sup> as a backup should Unbelted fall on that day.

Gulliver is autocrat for the event.

May Day - College of Voyagers - April 30 (Sat) tentatively decided upon. Voyagers will discuss it among themselves and get back to Trinette within a week so the dates can be submitted.

Angels Anniversary - Sept 10 - week between Potrero & Crown Tourney is open. All agreed.

Robin Hood Tourney - we think it'll be successful enough to want to repeat it. Looking at Sunday Oct 23<sup>rd</sup> (Archery events traditionally on Sunday). All agreed.

Angels Yule - Dec 3, 10, 17 - 17<sup>th</sup> is first choice, 10<sup>th</sup> is second choice. Hanukkah begins at sundown Dec 25.

Non-traditional Angels events:

Discussion of possibility of hosting Collegium, June Coronation/QC in 2005, or Twelfth Night in 2006. Nothing decided upon.

Doku knows of a park in El Monte off of Peck on lower Azusa. Water Conservation Park, a county park. He'll find out more information and pass it on.

Baronial Awards - Those who have received the Order of the Halo (A&S award) hang onto it. The name has bounced. The new one is the Order of Apollo, which is at Laurel. The device is a lyre, which passed. At Anniversary people will be receiving a promissory scroll until the device and name passes.
