Previous Meeting's Minutes:

Officer's Reports:

Seneschal - Trinettes - Letter from Ygraine, she's trying to get everyone's Regnum information corrected (paper to be passed around). There's been a lot going on through email, not much through the e-list. One of the things we need to do is get new officer's data. We are still looking for deputies for Chirurgeon, Childen, Boffers, and Chatelaine.
