New Business:

Robin Hood Tourney change of date - Baroness Morgaine - Baroness Bridget of Altavia requested that we switch RH & Agincourt Tournays so that Agincourt is closer to the historical date of the battle. Many think that the tournays would be too close together, so for a larger turnout we're considering moving the RH tourney to March 26 (2006) or May 21. (RH Tourney 2005 is on Oct 23). Decided on Mar 26, with a backup of the May date, also depending on the autocrating team, whomever that may be. Please give us your opinions on this, we need to finalize it relatively soon.

Calendar of Events for 2006 - Baroness Morgaine - Angels Anniversary 2006 was changed from the 2nd weekend in September as Collegium claimed the date to prevent conflict with the Jewish High Holy days. The 5th Saturday in September is the 30th, our event has been submitted for that date. We also have to schedule Voyager's Mayday, which is usually the first Sat of May 6, 2006. Angels Melee 2006 - Jan 14th 2006 would be the traditional date, or whatever the week after 12th night is.

Quarterly 5th Thursday - Baroness Morgaine - March, June, Sept, Dec - Due to interest in the bardic arts and the lack of places for people to practice and work on them, proposing a Bardic Thursday, inviting people from around the Kingdom to come and teach and practice or anything. There's been a lot of support from the Bardic list of people willing to travel here. We also have Mistress Lavendar, Sir Charles of Dublin, and Duchess Natalya locally who can come in and teach.

Progress Reports:

Angels 35th: Duchess Natalya - On Sept 10. The committee is growing, I expect & hope & beg everybody to help out with this. One of the goals is for everyone to feel like they're a part of the event by being part of the event. The theme is Travels Along the Silk Road. It's an all day event - fighting, games, chess, backgammon, music and banquet. If you have any ideas or anything they

want to say, please let me know. We are looking for a site with a large park and nearby feast hall with a HUGE kitchen.

Voyagers Mayday - Lord Tomaso - At this point, it's a simple event to put together. Collecting names for volunteers for all the little jobs. We want to continue the people's prize & demos in A&S this year. If anyone would like to teach, please let me know. A raffle is a possibility, auctioning the fighters, live demos for those walking through. Bardic/wandering minstrels to get more attention to that side of campus - engineering campus so SEIGE WEAPONS would be an excellent way to bring in people. Heraldic consultation, of course. Everyone with ideas contact Tomaso directly.

CP Prize Tourney - July 2, 2005 - A number of people volunteered to help with this. Lady Trinetta did contact everyone who volunteered to help to put a committee together. Lord Tomaso will reserve Beckman lawn & the side lawn, Duchess Natalya will speak with Trinetta and figure out who the autocrat is. CP is only partially subsidized, and putting it out is not cheap, this is an opportunity to raise money for the kingdom. Don't hesitate to contact Lady Mariam to be put on the planning committee list. Lady Rosamund proposed a Canterbury Tales-themed event with concession booths, auctions, games, "shrines". Baroness Morgaine would like to challenge her fellow Baronesses to donate an item made by them to an auction, similar to the Ladies of the Rose basket auction.
