Progress Reports:

We're expecting a pretty huge event, so we'll need a lot of land. The only way this event will work is if everybody participates, so if you're interested at ALL please let us know. We have a banquet committee, but are in need of cooks & staff when the menu is finalized. Please read through the event proposal update and see where you'd like to help out. We'll be doing some sewing classes - Lady Bhairavi will be showing how to wrap saris and make them stay! Talk it up, get your households going. We're the first barony turning 35, we've gotta do it right. Because we do not have a site, I have not been able to give Sir Einar the event proposal, but we'll be giving him something soon. Anything you donate, please let me know what your costs were - we can't reimburse everybody, but we can give you a note or receipt.

Old Business:

Rodak Tobias, and others once had a fundraiser where they dressed up in ratty monks' clothes begging for alms worked quite well in the past.
